Discover the amazing sights of the South Coast, such as Skogafoss waterfall and black sandy beaches and revitalize with an invigorating guided hike on Solheimajokull glacier. And no Icelandic spa break is complete without a soak in the mineral rich water of the world-renowned Blue Lagoon!

ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL AND RELAXATION

Geothermal Spa and Iceland's Cool Capital

Arrival at Keflavik Airport. The transfer coach for the transfer to the Blue Lagoon will be waiting outside the Arrivals Hall. Please show your Iceland Travel documents to the attendant on board the bus. *Please note that this is an unguided transfer, and you will not be met at the airport.* The Blue Lagoon is a twenty-minute drive from the airport. Enjoy the views of surreal lava terrain and the unique pollution-free Svartsengi power station as you head to the Lagoon. You can store your luggage at the Blue Lagoon's luggage facility, a small building near the entrance. The staff will store your luggage safely for a small fee.

Relax at the Blue Lagoon with the Comfort Experience, which includes towel rental, a Silica mud mask, and a choice of one drink from the Blue Lagoon's bar. The warm geothermal mineral water will soothe your skin and set you in the perfect Iceland frame of mind! Now that you are soothed and relaxed, it's time to head to Reykjavik on one of the scheduled transfer buses departing the Blue Lagoon. Please show your Iceland Travel documents to the attendant on board and let him or her know the hotel where you will be staying. The rest of the day is open for your own activities. Reykjavik has a wonderful variety of restaurants that suit many travel budgets. Choosing a place to dine will be a fun experience. Much of the food is fresh from the sea or farms, often with an organic focus. It's excellent cuisine for your wellness focused holiday! Your package also includes one entrance to your hotel's spa, which you can use anytime during your stay. Overnight in Reykjavik.

Accommodation: Reykjavik for 3 nights

Travel Tip: If your flight to Iceland doesn't match with the departure times for the airport transfer to the Blue Lagoon, we suggest that you visit the Blue Lagoon as part of your transfer back to the airport on your departure day. You would then transfer on your own to your hotel in Reykjavik.



DAY 2 GOLDEN CIRCLE AND SECRET LAGOON

Secret Lagoon – Gullfoss – Geysir – Thingvellir National Park
Breakfast at your hotel. Combine natural wonders and hot spring
relaxation in the Golden Circle region of South Iceland. You will
be picked up at your hotel or nearest tour bus stop (check with
your hotel staff regarding the tour departure point). A visit to
the Golden Circle in Iceland is on the top of many travelers'

bucket lists. The scenery is diverse and the activities that result

from it are exciting. Your first sight of the day being the multicolored Kerid Volcanic Crater Lake, a fascinating landmark created 3.000 years ago. Next up, you will stop at the Secret Lagoon, one of the oldest natural geothermal pools in Iceland. Your visit is during a quiet time of the day so you can enjoy the Secret Lagoon away from tourist crowds. The pool is nestled among bubbling hot springs and a small erupting geyser. Steam rises from the surrounding geothermal area as you relax in the warm mineral-rich water, with a temperature of $38 - 40^{\circ}\text{C}$ ($100 - 104^{\circ}\text{F}$) year-round. The little geyser near the pool erupts every few minutes, lending an exotic backdrop to your visit. After some relaxing time, your tour will head to the Geysir Geothermal Area. As you step on the walking path, your senses come alive as you are immediately greeted by the sulfuric smell, and bubbling mud pools in a land of mysterious steam vents, and dynamic, gushing hot springs. The



star of the show is the Strokkur Geyser, which erupts every 5 to 10 minutes. Next visit the astonishing Gullfoss Waterfall. The wide cascade drops in two stages, the first 11 meters (36 ft) then 21 meters (69 ft), roaring and tumbling down to the canyon, splashing up a massive screen of mist. Power from the waterfall can be felt even from a distance. The final stop is Thingvellir National Park, a unique location and significant in both Iceland's culture and geology. Althing, Iceland's parliament, was established by the Vikings here in 930 AD. You can also walk through a rift valley that sits on the divergent edge between the Eurasian and North American tectonic plates. (B)

DAY 3: SOUTH COAST ADVENTURE AND GLACIER HIKE

Spectacular Waterfalls – Amazing Glacier Views – Glacier Discoveries

Breakfast at your hotel. You will be picked up for today's tour at the hotel or nearest tour bus stop (check with the hotel reception about the tour departure location). Drive through the beautiful landscapes of Iceland's south coast, enjoying the view of peaceful farms, many with horses grazing in the fields. If the



sky is clear, you can view two famous volcanoes: Hekla (last eruption: 2000) and Eyjafjallajokull (last eruption: 2010). You might even glimpse the Westman Islands far off on the sea. Stop at Skogafoss waterfall, one of Iceland's most iconic cascades (make sure you have your camera ready for a selfie!). Perhaps you might even catch of glimpse of the legendary Viking treasure said to be buried in the falls. Travel east to Solheimajokull, a glacier extending out from the larger Myrdralsjokull. Here you'll put on crampons, grab an ice axe and join in on a glacier walk. Your glacier guide will lead you up onto the surface of the glacier for a one-hour walk in spellbinding icy landscapes. Enjoy views of jagged peaks, cool blue ice and wide- open sky, a real treat for photographers! You'll also learn about glaciers: how they are formed and why they are so important to our planet. After the invigorating ice walk, you'll visit beautiful Seljalandsfoss. This ribbon-like waterfall offers the rare opportunity to walk behind the curtain of water (subject to trail conditions at the time of the trip). Return to Reykjavik around 19:00 (7:00pm). Overnight in Reykjavik. (B)

Travel Tip: Bring warm outdoor clothing, waterproof jacket and pants, head wear and gloves. Hiking boots are strongly recommended. You can also rent hiking boots. Let us know at booking time, and we can arrange it.

DAY 4 DEPARTURE

Breakfast at your hotel. If you were not able to visit the Blue Lagoon on your arrival day, then you would use your transfer and stop at the Blue Lagoon on the way to Keflavik Airport. Otherwise, transfer on your own to the airport. If your flight is in the afternoon, use your last moments this morning enjoying the spa located right in your hotel or walk along the harbor seafront and breathe the fresh Atlantic breeze.

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

During this four-day adventure break, enjoy unforgettable experiences, including a thrilling ATV ride on a black sand beach, exploring the Golden Circle's natural treasures at your own pace, and relaxing in the Blue Lagoon. A highlight is a "back roads" tour of Iceland's south coast, including a visit to a wilderness ice cave.

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DAY 1 ARRIVAL AND RELAXATION

Welcome to Iceland! Your package includes an arrival or departure transfer via the Blue Lagoon, based on what best fits your flight schedule. Take an unguided transfer bus to the Blue Lagoon where you can enjoy bathing in the geothermal blue waters. The Blue Lagoon has a luggage facility near the entrance where you can safely store luggage for a small fee.

The Blue Lagoon is a unique natural pool of mineral rich geothermal water in the middle of a lava field surrounded by the beautiful Icelandic wilderness. The Blue Lagoon is known for its special properties and beneficial effects on the skin. Enjoy the facilities such as the Lagoon, sauna and steam room and a massage waterfall. You can stay in the Lagoon as long as you like and take one of the scheduled buses to your hotel in Reykjavik. Overnight in Reykjavik

Accommodation: Reykjavik for 3 nights

Travel Tip: If your flight to Iceland doesn't match with the departure times for the airport transfer to the Blue Lagoon, we suggest that you visit the Blue Lagoon as part of your transfer back to the airport on your departure day. You would then transfer on your own to your hotel in Reykjavik. We would be very happy to assist you with booking a transfer, if needed.

DAY 2 BLACK SAND BEACH ATV RIDE & THE GOLDEN CIRCLE

Spectacular ATV Beach Ride – Golden Waterfall – Erupting Geysers – A Walk between Continents Breakfast at your hotel. Today, you're in the driver's seat! Pick up your rental car and head off for a day of adventure in the south coast. Drive through the beautiful landscapes of Iceland's south, enjoying the view of peaceful farms, many with horses grazing in the fields. The road takes you to Thorlakshofn, a charming village on the southern coast. The ATVs and your guide are waiting for you! Get your adrenaline pumping as you shoot along a black sand beach and enjoy views of the ocean and coastline. Follow your guide on a tour racing along the beach. You'll then turn onto an inland trail that threads through grass-covered sand dunes for a closer look at Icelandic nature. Feel the freedom of Iceland!

After your invigorating ATV experience, continue exploring the Golden Circle area in your car. Visit the Geysir hot spring area, where a variety of interesting hot springs and colorful mud pots bubble, steam and send up plumes of steam. Nearby is the spectacular Gullfoss waterfall, where glacial water plunges over two ledges and deep into a canyon. Then head on to Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO world heritage site. This rift valley is the site where Vikings established an annual parliament in the 10th century. Thingvellir is also the meeting point for the North American and European tectonic plates; you have the rare opportunity to walk on a path that actually brings you between two continents! During the day, you might enjoy the chance to indulge in some hot spring relaxation with a visit to the Secret Lagoon, a stone-lined pool in a relaxed, low-key setting (+\$). Return to Reykjavik and drop off your car. Overnight in Reykjavik. (B)



DAY 3 SOUTH COAST SUPERJEEP TOUR AND ICE CAVE (small group tour)

Amazing Ice Cave – Spectacular Glacial Scenery – Hidden Natural Wonders – Famous Film Locations

Breakfast at your hotel. Today you'll explore the South Coast and backroad wilderness by SuperJeep. On your own, transfer to the meeting point of the tour where the tour's minibus will pick you up. The tour departs Reykjavik at 8:00am. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of the South Iceland on the way to Vik town, where you'll meet your local glacier guide and board a specially outfitted SuperJeep. Drive scenic back roads to Kotlujokull, a glacier "finger" crawling from Myrdalsjokull glacier. Here you'll get a safety briefing and gear up with a helmet, headlamp and crampons. Take an invigorating 10 – 15-minute glacier hike to a genuine ice cave. You'll certainly marvel at the cave's magnificent colors and crazy shapes! You'll learn how Katla volcano helped shape the ice cave. There will also be time to take pictures. Continue your glacier hike, hunting for secret waterfalls and glacier canyons. You'll also visit one or two other ice caves depending on the current conditions of the glacier. Your local glacier guides are experts in finding the best caves available. Hike back to the SuperJeep and drive to a private black sand beach off the beaten path and away from the crowds. You'll then visit the actual film set of Star Wars Rogue One's opening scenes, along with filming locations for Transformers, Noah and Oblivion. Head back to Reykjavik, stopping at the two famous waterfalls of Skogafoss and Seljalandsfoss. Return to Reykjavik in the evening. (B)

Note: Please wear warm clothing for cold weather, along with waterproof rainwear, hat and gloves. Hiking boots are essential. Bring a packed lunch and water (the tour will stop at a shop along the way where you can purchase food). Maximum tour size: 12 participants – Level of difficulty: **Moderate**

DAY 4 DEPARTURE

Breakfast at your hotel. If you were not able to visit the Blue Lagoon on your arrival day, then you would use your transfer and stop at the Blue Lagoon on the way to Keflavik Airport. Otherwise, transfer on your own to the airport. If your flight is in the afternoon, use your last moments enjoying the spa located right in your hotel or walk along the harbor seafront and breathe the fresh Atlantic breeze.

Escape the everyday rush and head to the Arctic Circle for relaxation and wellness on top of the world! Cozy, friendly Husavik town is known for excellent whale watching. Husavik is also known for its wellness focus with the beautiful new GeoSea Baths, clean air, good food, yoga workshops, and some of the most beautiful views of sea and mountains you'll experience. Enjoy hot spring bathing and an eco-friendly whale watching tour. You can also add in day tours to Diamond Circle wonders such as Lake Mývatn, Ásbyrgi Canyon, and Dettifoss.

- ✓ Enjoy a relaxing visit to a charming, wellness-focused village on the edge of the Arctic Circle
- ✓ Bathe in soothing geothermal sea water in an outdoor spa with amazing scenery.

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DAY 1 ARRIVAL AND UNIQUE, ECO-FRIENDLY WHALE WATCHING

<u>Note</u>: You can choose to visit the GeoSea Baths or do the Whale Watching on either day 1 or day 2. Please advise us of your preference when booking your trip.

On your own transfer to Reykjavik Domestic Airport for your afternoon flight to Husavik. The Eagle Air Terminal is in its own section of the airport, located directly behind the Icelandair Hotel Natura. Please check into your flight no later than 30 minutes before your flight.



Enjoy the Eagle Air flight to Husavik. Eagle Air is a family-owned airline with a focus on supporting local tourism in rural Iceland. If the day is clear, you might get a view of the beautiful highland wilderness during your flight. After you pick up your luggage, head to the arrivals area where the driver of your transfer shuttle will be waiting. You will be taken to your hotel in Husavik. Your driver will also arrange with you when you would like to be taken to the GeoSea baths and set up your transfers for that (you can arrange to visit the GeoSea baths either today or tomorrow). Husavik is a friendly and charming fishing village overlooking the Arctic Circle. The view of the mountains and sea is very relaxing and inspiring, and there is a sense of peace in the town.



An authentic Icelandic fishing town, Husavik has around 2,300 inhabitants. The characteristic centennial wooden church in the center, is surrounded by colorful houses, and the harbour is bustling with small fishing boats and whale watchers. The town also has a nice variety of restaurants, pubs, cafes, a bakery, and a microbrewery. Most recently the town became known from the popular Netflix film *Eurovision Song Contest: The Story of Fire Saga*. Whale watching has been a great importance and Husavik has become known as the Whale Watching

Capital of Iceland. Today you will take part in a unique type of whale tour. Your hotel is a short walk to the pier where your whale watching will depart. Your confirmed time will be on the voucher. Please board the boat no later than 20 minutes before the departure.

Can you imagine anything better than sailing around Skjalfandi Bay with pods of whales all around? Sailing around Skjalfandi Bay on board the most animal – and environmentally friendly whale watching vessels in the world! Your historical wooden fishing boat has a modern twist — it has an electric motor and completely silent. The boat glides through the sea, giving you the opportunity to quietly approach the whales with minimal disturbance. This sustainable approach is combined with a professional crew specially trained in responsible conduct with the whales. Reduce your carbon footprint down to zero while your marine-expert guides help you search for marine creatures. Sightings might include minke whales, humpback whales, harbor porpoises and sperm whales. The rest of the day is open. Husavik has a nice variety of restaurants serving healthy and regional cuisine. The specialty is fresh caught fish and free-range lamb from locally sourced farms, as well as vegetables grown in eco-friendly geothermal greenhouses. Overnight in Husavik.

Accommodation: Husakvik for 2 nights DAY 2 GEOSEA BATHS & LEISURE TIME

Breakfast at your hotel. Today you will visit the amazing GeoSea Baths on the edge of Husavik. The area near the town contains a unique source of geothermally heated seawater that the residents enjoyed for bathing since the mid twentieth century. A lovely new spa opened in 2019. Enjoy the opportunity to relax in hot seawater, letting the minerals soothe and rejuvenate your skin and joints. Breathe in the crisp, pure air as you enjoy the view of the mountains, Skjalfandi Bay



and the Arctic Circle. The rest of the day is open for your own activities. We highly recommend a visit to the Husavik Whale Museum, located near the harbor (+\$). Inside you'll see interesting exhibits about different species of whales, along with amazing facts about whale evolution and biology. Husavik has several other museums, including the Exploration Museum with the focus on the Apollo astronaut training near Husavik, and the Husavik Safnahusid with a focus on North



Iceland's history and nature. If you want to explore outside of town, we recommend a day tour of the famous Diamond Circle region (+\$). You'll visit the horseshoe shaped Asbyrgi Canyon, the powerful Dettifoss waterfall and the volcanic wonderland of Lake Myvatn (the tour is generally 10-12 hours). Perhaps you might consider an afternoon/evening visit to the Myvatn Nature Reserve, a volcanic wonderland with surreal landscapes and the possibility to relax at the Myvatn Nature baths (+\$). Visit the colorful town of Akureyri, known for its spectacular fjord setting and lively cultural scene. Husavik also offers wonderful wellness experiences near the Arctic Circle, including private yoga and gong meditation sessions, massage, as well as float therapy sessions at the GeoSea Baths (+\$). Overnight in Husavik. (B)

DAY 3: MORNING AT LEISURE – AFTERNOON FLIGHT TO REYKJAVÍK

Breakfast at your hotel. Enjoy your morning and early afternoon relaxing in Husavik. Maybe you'll book a private yoga session or take a swim in the local geothermal pool (+\$). Or perhaps just enjoy a walk along the harbor and breathing in the fresh sea air. Or just linger with coffee and pastry in a local café. Hotel check out is at noon, and you can safely store your luggage at the hotel until it is time for your transfer. You will be transferred from your hotel to the Husavik airport for your afternoon flight back to Reykjavik. Your trip ends in the Reykjavik Domestic airport. (B)

Want to add extra nights? Speak to your travel agent – There are many reasons to linger longer in Husavik!



DAY 3 SECRET LAGOON & THE GOLDEN CIRCLE: SECRET LAGOON — GULLFOSS — GEYSIR — ÞINGVELLIR NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast at your hotel. Today you will travel out of the city and into the Icelandic countryside. The Golden Circle refers to The 'Big Three' – Geysir hot springs, Gullfoss waterfalland Thingvellir National Park. You'll get to visit all three on this great day tour. Begin the tour with a leisurely soak in the Secret Lagoon, one of the oldest natural geothermal pools in Iceland. The pool is nestled amongst bubbling hot springs and a small erupting geyser. Steam rises from the surrounding geothermal area as you relax in the warm mineral-rich water, with a temperature of 38-40°C (100-104°F) year-round. A little geyser near the pool erupts every few minutes, giving the pool an otherworldly air. A footpath around the pool lets you view the area's bubbling geothermal features, making the Secret Lagoon a hot spring bathing experience like no other.

Then drive to the Geysir geothermal area in Haukadalur Valley with many bubbling pools and spouting geysers. Continue to Gullfoss, the 'Golden Waterfall', The most famous of the country's many waterfalls. Here the river Hvita drops 96 feet (30 meters) in two falls, creating an awesome spectacle. Then onward to the historic and geological wonder of Thingvellir National Park, one of the most outstanding landscapes in the country. The area is surrounded by mountains and encompasses a vast lava plain and Iceland's largest lake. In 2004, Thingvellir was added to UNESCO's World Heritage List. Return and overnight in Reykjavik. (B)

DAY 4: DEPARTURE FROM REYKJAVIK

If your flight is in the afternoon, use your last moments to walk along the harbor seafront and breathe the fresh Atlantic breeze. If you still need to relax, visit one of the city's swimming pools. There you can chat with the locals while lounging in the geothermal steam. (B)

Once the area where fishermen worked, the Harbor has become a neighborhood for boat tours and whale watching, museums, art galleries and a fantastic foodie culture.

This morning you are booked for the FlyOver Iceland amazing flight simulated experience. FlyOver Iceland utilizes state-of-the-art technology to give you the feeling of flight. In addition to the flight, you'll also be immersed in interactive multi-media experiences to learn about Iceland's nature and culture. Enjoy two fun and educational experiences before your flight. First, you'll meet a friendly old Icelandic storyteller sitting by the fireside in a Viking longhouse. He'll weave a wonderful tale as shadows act it out behind him. Afterwards, step into the Well of Time, where you'll discover Iceland's past. You'll see how violent forces of fire and ice created the island millions of years ago. Then it's time for the flight! Board special flight seats where you'll hang suspended, feet dangling, before a wrap-around 20-metre (66-foot) spherical screen. A film whisks you away on an exhilarating journey across Iceland. Soar over glaciers, waterfalls, vast volcanic wilderness, and black sand beaches while soul stirring music plays. Special effects, including wind, mist and scents create an unforgettable experience as if you are actually flying over untamed wilderness wonders (the flight is about 8.5 minutes; combined with the pre-flight shows the whole experience is about 35 minutes).

The rest of the day is open to enjoy Reykjavik your way. The Old Harbor area has plenty of activities your family will love. We've included some suggestions (+\$):

- Take a boat tour to look for whales or puffins.
- Meet life-size replicas of whales and dolphins and learn amazing facts about marine life at the Whales of Iceland exhibit.



- Check out exciting films about volcanic eruptions, glaciers and northern lights at the cozy Cinema of Fire, Ice and Theatre
- Experience the Icelandic Sagas and Viking history at the Saga Museum with lifelike wax figures
- ➤ Board a Coast Guard vessel and see how people worked at sea in the 1950s at the Reykjavik Maritime Museum
- ➤ Getting hungry? Head over to the Old Harbor's Grandi Food Hall. Everyone in the family is sure to find something great to eat in this collection of artisanal street food. Afterwards, wander over to the Valdis ice cream parlor to try some of Reykjavik's best homemade ice cream.
- Another idea today is to visit the interactive Wonders of Iceland at the Pearl. You can walk through a real ice cave, feel the power of volcanoes and earthquakes, and watch a planetarium show about northern lights. There is also a 360° observation deck where you can see the whole city and the mountains ringing it.
- Perhaps you'll end the exciting day with a visit to one of the outdoor geothermal pools.

Return to Reykjavik for the night. (B)

DAY 3 GOLDEN CIRCLE AND LAVA CAVE

A Walk Between Continents – Erupting Geysers – Golden Waterfall – Colorful Lava Formations

Breakfast at your hotel. Today remember to wear comfortable outdoor shoes, such as hiking boots, for the visit to the cave. We also recommended bringing a warm and waterproof jacket since the cave sometimes has water dripping from the ceiling. (Temperature in the cave is 0-4°C or 32-38°F). Pick up your rental



car and set off to explore the Golden Circle, Iceland's most famous collection of natural wonders (please check your confirmation to see what time your visit to the Lava Tunnel has been booked)! First, visit Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site. You will see where the Vikings formed the world's oldest parliament in the 9th century and learn about how Icelanders would travel from all over the island once a year to meet here and make important decisions for the country. This is also where the European and North American tectonic plates meet. You can walk on a path that actually takes you between both continents! Afterwards, visit the surreal Geysir geothermal area where a series of hot springs and mud pools bubble away. The Strokkur geyser shoots a high plume of steam into the air every few minutes; keep your camera ready! Nearby is Gullfoss, the Golden Falls, believed to be Iceland's most beautiful waterfall. You can wander on footpaths leading around the falls for amazing views of the glacier water plunging into a deep canyon.

During the day, we also suggest a visit to Fridheimar, a geothermal greenhouse where vegetables are grown using geothermal energy. There is a café where you can enjoy some of the best tomato soup in Iceland. The Efstidalur dairy farm is a great place to stop to try home-made ice cream. In the ice cream café, you can peek through a window overlooking the barn and see the cows who provide the milk for the ice cream. On your way back to town, head to Raufarholshellir, the Lava Tunnel. (Make sure to arrive no later than 15 minutes before your booked time). The certified cave guide will take you into this magnificent lava tunnel. Created by a volcanic eruption over 5.000 years ago, the tunnel shows spectacular colors and lava formations. Your guide will tell you



about how the tunnel was created. You might feel as you are seeing a volcano from the inside out! Return to Reykjavik and drop off your car. Overnight in Reykjavik. (B)



DAY 4 WILDERNESS ADVENTURE

Volcanic Views – Colorful Wilderness Wonderland – Hot Spring River or Frozen Ice Cave

Remember to dress well in layers and wear good outdoor shoes (such as hiking boots). Bring a wind and waterproof jacket. If you are visiting Landmannalaugar, bring a swimsuit and towel. Bring a packed lunch and water (the tour will stop at a shop along the way where you can purchase food). You'll be heading into the wilderness highlands of Iceland's

interior. No one lives here, but it is a fun place to visit with a taste of adventure included. Expect bumpy roads, water crossings and some spectacular scenery and crisp air.

Breakfast at your hotel. <u>Today you have a choice between two tours</u>: a SuperJeep tour to Landmannalaugar or a minibus and SuperJeep tour to visit the South Coast and a wilderness ice cave.

Landmannalaugar Option:

Board a SuperJeep, a specially outfitted vehicle with large tires that can handle the unpaved rocky mountain tracks of the wilderness. Your driver guide will whisk you through the southern farmlands onto an unpaved mountain track leading towards Mount Hekla. This beautiful volcano is one of Iceland's most frequently erupting (last eruption was 2000). In the Middle Ages, people in Europe believed it was the entrance to Hell. You'll get as close as possible to the volcano before heading into a fire and ice landscapes so bizarre that you'll understand why Hollywood movies have been made in this area. Drive through a river and into Landmannalaugar nature reserve. This is a strange world where steam rises from the ground and the mountains show brilliant colors of red, orange and gold. If you're up for it your guide will take you on a short hike to get a better view over the mountains, glacier ice and steaming hot springs. Then relax in a unique river that is a blend of cool spring water and underground hot springs — it's the perfect temperature for a bath. You've experienced nothing like this: to bathe in a mountain hot spring in a colorful world of ice and fire. Depending on road and weather conditions, today's tour might visit beautiful Thorsmork, a beloved nature getaway for Icelandic families. Start with a visit to the elegant Seljalandsfoss waterfall.

South Coast and Ice Cave Tour Option:

On your own, transfer to the meeting point of the tour where the tour's minibus will pick you up. The tour departs Reykjavik at 8:00am. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of the South Iceland on the way to Vik town, where you'll meet your local glacier guide and board a specially outfitted SuperJeep. Drive scenic back roads to Kotlujokull, a glacier "finger" crawling from Myrdalsjokull glacier. Here you'll get a safety briefing and gear up with a helmet, headlamp and crampons. Take an invigorating 10-15-minute glacier hike to a genuine ice cave. You'll certainly marvel at the cave's magnificent colors and crazy shapes! You'll learn how Katla volcano helped shape the ice cave. There will also be time to take pictures. Continue your glacier hike, hunting for secret waterfalls and glacier canyons. You'll also visit one or two other ice caves depending on the current conditions of the glacier. Your local glacier guides are experts in finding the best caves available. Hike back to the SuperJeep and drive to a private black sand beach off the beaten path and away from the crowds. You'll then visit the actual film set of Star Wars Rogue One's opening scenes, along with filming locations for Transformers, Noah and Oblivion. Head back to Reykjavik,



stopping at the two famous waterfalls of Skogafoss and Seljalandsfoss. Return to Reykjavik in the evening.
