ITINERARY

DAY 1 HOBART

After you arrive in Hobart you will be transferred to your hotel and are able to spend the rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 2 HOBART

Join your Bruny Island Cruises tour at the Pennicott Wilderness Journeys Waterfront Booking Center on Franklin Wharf next to the Constitution Dock. Travel to Kettering where you will then join the transfer to Bruny Island. On the island, join an eco-adventure cruise aboard a specialized 12.5 meter vessel which is electronically balanced for high fuel efficiency and features covered open-aired seating for excellent all round viewing. Travel along the island's rugged coast and spot sea life and coastal wildlife. View some of Australia's highest sea cliffs and enter deep sea caves. After cruise enjoy lunch before heading back to Hobart.

DAY 3 HOBART

Experience the powerful sense of our past convict era and of the early Australian settlement heritage that the Port Arthur Historic Site evokes. Sitting tranquilly amidst English oaks and gardens it is a harsh contrast to the beauty of the Tasman Peninsula. Your tour starts in Hobart travelling across the Tasman Bridge, through Eaglehawk Neck, onto the Tasman Peninsula. Wonder at the spectacle of Tasman Arch and the magnitude of Devils Kitchen and enjoy superb views of the rugged coastline. Take a guided walking tour of Port Arthur with access to over 30 ruins and restored buildings.

DAY 4 HOBART

Say farewell to Hobart as you are transferred to the airport for your forward travel plans.
