



### **DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN TORONTO**



Located in Algonquin Provincial Park approximately 2 hours north of Toronto, the Algonquin Winter Log Cabin offers fantastic opportunities for snowshoeing, backcountry skiing, and torch lit skating. Frozen lakes, waist-deep snow, wildlife tracks, the howl of a wolf and the crisp, clear air are just a few of the delights of a winter adventure. Enjoy delicious meals and relax at night in a cozy, log cabin. Included transfers between downtown Toronto hotels and the Cabin make discovering the beauty of Canada's first provincial park easy and convenient. A special Holiday Package is available, featuring special menus and excursions to celebrate the season.



### **2 NIGHT PACKAGE**

### **DAY 1 TORONTO - ALGONQUIN PROVINCIAL PARK**

Your adventure begins with the Voyageur Quest shuttle van picking you up at your downtown hotel (pick-ups are between 07:00-08:00), and arriving at Algonquin Log Cabin at 12:30. After a tasty lunch, snowshoe to a forest lookout while looking for wildlife tracks in the snow and learning about winter life in Algonquin Provincial Park. Return to the Log Cabin for appetizers and dinner in front of a stone fireplace. Afterwards, guests are invited to try their hand at torch-lit broomball or skating on the lake. Lunch, dinner and appetizers / snacks included. Overnight in the Algonquin Log Cabin. (L/D)

Accommodation: Algonquin Provincial Park for 2 nights

### DAY 2 SKIING OR SNOWSHOEING IN ALGONQUIN PROVINCAL PARK

After a tasty breakfast Canadian breakfast, enjoy a brief orientation of backcountry cross country skiing before embarking as a group across Surprise Lake to travel the island circuit. Stride and glide through the hemlock trails and enjoy the silence of the snow laden forest. Return for a lunch of steaming hot soup, warm beer bread and fresh salad. In the afternoon, many options are available to guests: Ski or snowshoe the highlands of Kettle Lake/Cardiac Hill, or ski to the heated wall tent further down on Surprise Lake. Guests may decide to relax in front of the fire before an afternoon sauna, cocktails and then a home cooked feast finishes the day. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks included. Overnight in the Algonquin Log Cabin. (B/L/D)

### DAY 3 ALGONQUIN PROVINCIAL PARK TO TORONTO / END OF PACKAGE

After breakfast, take one last morning to explore the ridge trail by ski, or snowshoe to Moose Bay. Enjoy lunch in a heated wall tent and learn about reflector oven cooking before making your way back to the log cabin for a final sauna. Check out and depart for Toronto, arriving at approximately 15:00. Breakfast and lunch included. (B/L)

### **ACCOMMODATION DESCRIPTION**

The Algonquin Log Cabin, beautifully situated on the shores of Surprise Lake, can accommodate up to 12 guests and offers comfortable amenities while preserving an interior decor that is simple and in harmony with nature. Cabin features include shared indoor washroom facilities, kitchen, and dining area with fireplace, lounge, double occupancy rooms, wide porch, and sauna with access to hot shower (separate building). There is no cell phone coverage or electricity in the cabin.

Evening's feature gathering in the Aurora Teepee Village and watching in comfort as the brilliantly beautiful Aurora dances across the northern sky.



### DAY 1 ARRIVE AT YELLOWKNIFE AIRPORT - YELLOWKNIFE

Please note: The below is a suggested itinerary. Some tours may be substituted with alternate, pre-booked tours – these are listed after the itinerary.

Arriving at Yellowknife Airport, guests who have arrived on Air Canada & WestJet flights will be met by a representative of Aurora Village at the arrivals gate. Afterwards, you are transferred to your Yellowknife hotel and are assisted with your check in. (<u>Passengers arriving on other airlines may use the free shuttle between Yellowknife Airport and downtown hotels to arrive independently at the hotel.</u>)

After getting settled and fitting your winter weather clothes, depart with your guide to Aurora Village for your first evening of Aurora viewing! Warm up in a picturesque teepee glowing in the night, wood fire stove burning, heated seats and choose from a delicious selection of hot beverages. Situated around the village on high ground and away from the lights of the city, the view of the Aurora is unsurpassed. After your viewing, you are transferred back to your Yellowknife hotel.

### DAY 2 YELLOWKNIFE - AURORA VILLAGE

Today is a day of adventure! After being picked up at your hotel mid-day, embark on a guided dogsledding excursion. Board a traditional sled towed by an enthusiastic dog team for an exciting ride over the frozen lake and through the wooded trails. ### DAY 2 MOUNT LOGAN LODGE

After breakfast at 08:00, depart on your morning of adventure!
